## Area Missionary News

The partnership with the North American Mission Board (NAMB) and the Shasta Baptist Association's (SBA) Director of Missions position is changing. The Send North America Strategy is to start new ministries and churches utilizing the current NAMB funded missionaries to become Church Planting Catalysts (CPC).

The SBA pastors met on two occasions and in a general consensus concluded that Church Strengthening and Leadership Development should be the responsibility of the local churches. Supporting, encouraging, and helping one another is what association is about. Also, the California Southern Baptist Convention (CSBC) is available to assist in these two areas.

The NAMB CPC will assist in the starting, re-starting, and networking of new works, sponsor churches, and church planters and teams. Therefore, my position as DOM is no longer a funded position.
